Eligibility includes:

- Jefferson County residents within 150% of the 2019-20 Income Guidelines
- Schedule a "drop off" appointment in advance.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS

- Proof of <u>all household income</u> for the <u>prior month</u> (Ex. Food Stamp award letter, Social Security Award letter, pay stubs, etc. or other proof of \$0 income). Note: Zero Income forms are available at the LIHEAP "Drop Box" lcations or online at www.louisvilleky.gov/LIHEAP
- Social Security Card(s) (or official documentation with Social Security Numbers) or Permanent Residence card (Green Card) for <u>each member of the household</u>; and
- Your most current heating bill, <u>OR</u> statement from your landlord if heating expenses are included in your rent.

At this time, <u>all LIHEAP offices are closed for public foot traffic</u>. Clients will be served remotely.

- After <u>scheduling an appointment</u>, <u>drop off</u> all required documentation in a secure drop box <u>on the day of your</u> <u>appointment</u>, anytime between 8 a.m. and noon; or 1 and 4:30 p.m. Please drop off clean copies of your documents instead of originals, if possible.
- Fill out the Family Profile Forms and the Remote Processing Forms that are provided at the drop box or found online at www.louisvilleky.gov/LIHEAP. Place the forms and your documentation in an envelope and drop into the secure drop box at the site you selected when making your appointment (listed below). Please label the envelope "LIHEAP".
- You will not need to wait at the site for a LIHEAP staff member to call you to process in person.
- You will be contacted within 72 hours (3 business days) of your appointment time. If you have dropped off original documents, the workers will make arrangements to return any original documents.
